Approved, signed and filed the Commissioners' Proceedings for the week of October 1, 2001.

Approved, signed and filed amended staff salary adjustments for Fiscal Year 2001-2002, Prosecutor's Office, subject to verification by County Auditor.

Approved, signed and filed staff salary adjustments for Fiscal Year 2001-2002, Youth Services, subject to verification of County Auditor.

Filed the resignation of Bradley Dorendorf, Detention Deputy, Sheriff, Department 04E, Line 13, effective October 1, 2001.
