3. The Board of County Commissioners shall approve the Harvard Community Hall for a polling place to be used for both the Latah County Special Bond Election and the HooDoo Special Revenue Bond Election.

Filed Youth Services report for the year January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002.

By Motion and Order, approved the submission of a grant application by the County for the Sheriff's Office to the Idaho State Parks and Recreation Off-Road Motor Vehicle Fund for a grant in the amount of \$21,955 to purchase 2 ATV's, radios, trailer, and first aid supplies. The County will provide an in-kind match of \$2452 in the form of labor from the Sheriff's Office for patrol and equipment maintenance; and Rural Development Services for grant administration. Chris Storhok, Rural Development Services Coordinator will serve as grant administrator.

Approved and signed a letter of support to the Idaho State Parks & Recreation for the grant application submitted by the County for the Sheriff's Office for the purchase of ATV's and equipment to aid in patrol of areas such as trails, parks, and unimproved roads.

Signed and sent a letter to the City of Moscow stating the Boards' position on the formation of a Combined Micropolitan Statistical Area (CMSA), and requesting the city delay any action to form a CMSA.
