RESOLUTION 2015-20**

A RESOLUTION OF LATAH COUNTY, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, REPEALING RESOLUTIONS #2003-09, #2005-05, #2010-18, and #2015-16 AND ALL AMENDMENTS THERETO; ADOPTING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE LATAH COUNTY GIS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Latah County, State of Idaho is the duly elected governing body of Latah County, a political subdivision of the State of Idaho, having such powers and duties as are set forth in the Constitution and Statutes of the State of Idaho; and

WHEREAS, Latah County has established a Geographic Information System (GIS) which provides for all mapping and geographic information and services in the County; and

WHEREAS, Latah County provides a system of information retrieval and reproduction for this system, and said information is frequently requested by persons and organizations (subject to Idaho Code §74-120); and

WHEREAS, Latah County desires to recover the incremental costs of providing the GIS data to the public and other agencies and a reasonable portion of the costs associated with the development, annual maintenance and dissemination of the GIS; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-875 provides that the Board of Commissioners of Latah County may impose and collect fees for GIS and establishes the procedure for such; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Latah County passed Resolution #2003-09, setting forth fees for the purchase of paper maps produced by Latah County as well as copies of digital data from the GIS database, which was subsequently changed by Resolutions #2005-05, #2010-18, and #2015-16; and

WHEREAS, after review of these resolutions, updates were deemed necessary; and

WHEREAS, fee amounts are not changing from the amounts previously established and are not an increase, and because of that special notice as set forth in Idaho Code §63-1311A is not required;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Latah County, State of Idaho, pursuant to all applicable Idaho Codes, that:

**SECTION 1: REPEAL OF PRIOR RESOLUTIONS**

That Resolution #2003-09 and all amendments thereto, Resolution #2005-05 and all amendments thereto, Resolution #2010-18 and all amendments thereto, and Resolution #2015-16, and all amendments thereto are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: ADOPTION OF THE LATAH COUNTY GIS FEE SCHEDULE

That the Board adopt the following fee schedule:


SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY




SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE
