

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
LATAH COUNTY**

The Latah County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing at 1:30 p.m. on Monday, December 20, 2010, in Room 2-B of the Latah County Courthouse, 522 S. Adams, Moscow, Idaho, to take comments on amending the Latah County Comprehensive Plan, Resolution #94-17 as amended, as follows:

Change the order of the Objectives; add to Section 4: Goals- “Encourage business development which supports local employment” and “To encourage business development that is consistent with the available infrastructure, available natural resources, and the underlying zoning designations”, and to Policies-Agriculture and Forestry- “Encourage agricultural and forestry diversification and experimentation and value added industries” and “Encourage local and regional food self sufficiency”, and to Policies-Commercial and Industrial- “Encourage business development that is consistent with the goals in this element” and “Encourage recreational business development based on the county’s outdoor recreational opportunities”; add to Section 8-Policies “Encourage awareness and conservation of unique natural resources in Latah County, such as Palouse Prairie” and “Protect access to public lands in Latah County”; add to Section 10-Policy 1 “wildland urban interface”; modify the land use designation for all of Section 6, T40N, R5W except for the SW1/4, SW1/4, the NW1/4, SW1/4 and the SW1/4, NW1/4 of Section 6 to include a new designation of “Agriculture/Forest/Residential”; remove #7 from Section 13; add a new Section 15 “Water Resources”; and update the inventories.

The hearing will be held pursuant to the Latah County Hearing Procedures Ordinance and under authority of the Idaho Local Land Use Planning Act. Interested parties are encouraged to attend. Accommodations for individuals who qualify under the ADA are available upon request. Notice is required 3 working days prior to the hearing to acquire accommodations.
