Chairman Steve Heick called the meeting to order at 5:40 pm.

Those present were Tony Johnson, Kenny Cada, Nancy Largent, and Suvia Judd

Tony moved to accept the minutes from the last meeting, Nancy seconded, motion passed.

The election of officers was held.

Tony nominated Steve to remain the chairman, Nancy seconded, motion passed.

Steve nominated Tony as vice-chairman, Nancy seconded, motion passed.

Michelle told all that there is a vacancy on the zoning commission as Wayne Sprouse has retired. The person usually comes from the planning commission, and if anyone is interested, please let Michelle know.

Michelle has not heard if Cindy Agidius wants to remain on the planning commission and will attempt to get an answer. If not, we will need to fill her position.

Suvia had some thoughts regarding the land use ordinance. She mentioned regional food self sufficiency and informed all that a seminar will be coming up in the near future. Michelle sent out a flyer on it. She also mentioned that if someone wanted a recreational business at a trailhead, it would not be allowed. Michelle said that if we wanted to add it to ag/forest, we would have to address it. It might be allowed in the city, but trails outside Moscow would be difficult. The group discussed how survival schools, etc. might be considered under schools with a CUP. Would a commercial kitchen be allowed outside of city limits?

Our group is trying to come up with what might be roadblocks for businesses in our county.

Michelle will check on some food related items for Suvia. For instance, if food is not grown on the ag property (using neighbor's product or buying apples someplace else to make apple products or buying wheat someplace else to make noodles), would it be allowed?

We discussed having a public meeting before any changes go to the public hearing so that we can get more input from the county.

We are all to think of any topics for future agenda items.
