The Latah County Sheriff's Office is seeking qualified candidates for the position of Level I Reserve Deputy Sheriff to serve the community. This is a non-paid position which will supplement our full-time peace officers in the Operations Division.

Applicants must be 21 years of age with a high school diploma or equivalent. Candidates must pass written test and oral interview. Successful applicants will undergo physical agility testing and extensive background investigation to include a polygraph examination.

Unless certified by Idaho POST as a peace officer or a Level I Reserve, those accepted into the program must complete or challenge the POST Level I Reserve Academy Course (233 hours); graduate from our Field Training Officer Program; and volunteer a minimum of 20 hours per month with a two-year commitment to the position.

To apply, applicants must fill out a Latah County Law Enforcement Application which can be downloaded at <http://www.latah.id.us/employment/>. **Completed applications including a cover letter are to be submitted to the Latah County Sheriff's Office**, P.O. Box 8068, Moscow, Idaho 83843.

In addition to submitting an application, The Latah County Sheriff's Office uses *National Testing Network* to administer the written and physical tests for applicants. Applicants must sign up at www.nationaltestingnetwork.com to schedule a testing time and location.

What to expect at the www.nationaltestingnetwork.com website:

- Instructions for completing the testing process
- Information related to the Moscow Police Department police officer position, including minimum requirements, salary and benefits.
- Detailed information about the testing process for the entry level test.
- Ability to schedule your test time. Tests times and testing locations are listed on the website.

All applications must be submitted and testing completed by Monday, November 14, 2016.

Upon completion of the testing, candidate scores are automatically forwarded to the Latah County Sheriff Office. Candidates who attain a passing score on both the entry level exam and the physical abilities test will be placed on the department's eligibility list. The Latah County Sheriff Office will contact candidates on the list and will invite them to continue to participate in other stages of the selection process. Latah County will provide a preference in employment to eligible veterans of the U.S. Armed Services.
