RE: Prescription Drug Take Back October 22nd, 2016

On Saturday October 22nd from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. the Latah County Sheriff's Office, with support from the Latah County Youth Advocacy Council and the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), will give the public an opportunity to prevent Rx drug abuse and theft by ridding their homes of potentially dangerous expired, unused, and unwanted prescription drugs. All solid dosage pharmaceutical products and liquids in consumer containers may be accepted. Liquid products, such as cough syrup, should remain sealed in their original container. The depositor should ensure that the cap is tightly sealed to prevent leakage. Intra-venous solutions, injectables, syringes, chemotherapy medications, or medical waste **WILL NOT** be accepted due to potential hazard posed by blood-borne pathogens. The service is free and anonymous, no questions asked. Funding for this program is provided exclusively by the Latah County Youth Advocacy Council.
