Yard Waste: Includes grass, leaves, and branches less than 4' length & 6" diameter.

Oil: In containers no larger than 5-gallons. Residential use only. **No antifreeze.**

**Accepted during operating hours:

E-waste: (TV/DVD, computers, monitors, fax/copiers/printers, etc.); spiral CFL bulbs; bikes; shredded paper; radiators; phones; rechargeable batteries; aluminum sheet and copper/brass.

There is a minimum \$10.00 fee for up to: 200 lbs. household waste, 460 lbs. demolition waste; or 280 lbs. mixed waste.

Inert Demolition Waste: \$31.65 per ton

Household Waste: \$77.00 per ton

Tire Recycling: \$157.95 per ton

Asbestos: \$167.50/ton 24-hour call notice required.

Yard Waste: Includes untreated & clean lumber
Free compost to Latah residents, when available.

Metal: All metals and large appliances.

Rural Service

Latah County is responsible for waste removal under state and federal regulations. The goal is to keep Latah County clean.

Solid Waste fees are mandatory for occupied homes in Latah County. Fees fund all waste disposal and recycling programs.



Latah County Solid Waste Ordinance:

Maintenance and operation of the rural solid waste collection system shall be funded by assessment and collection of a fee imposed upon all premises in Latah County, except those located within the corporate limits of any city.

Roll Cart Program

Roll carts must be at the end of driveway by 7am. Waste must be bagged inside roll cart and not packed tightly. Failure to do this hinders servicing and results in trash blowing out of truck or getting stuck in cart and not removed. If roads are impassable extra waste will be collected the following week free of charge. Please contact the office with any garbage collection problems as they occur.

****BILLING CHANGES****

Fees will be billed quarterly and must be paid no later than the 15th of March, June, September and December to avoid \$10.00 late fees. Fees for extras will be placed on the following quarters bill. Unpaid fees are collected with property taxes. To stop billing exemption forms and information are available in the office or at www.latah.id.us/solidwaste. Monthly automatic bank deductions can be set up for free. Credit/debit cards carry a 2.5% service fee (minimum \$1.50).

Bovill: Railroad Ave, across from City Hall

Deary: Line St near bulky waste site

Genesee: Oak & Pine Sts, by yard waste bin

Juliaetta: 3rd and Railroad

Kendrick: 8th & Railroad St, by yard waste bin

Potlatch: City Hall parking lot

Troy: Hwy 8, Sunset Mart lot

Rinse containers & discard all lids (unrecyclable)

Plastics: Must be at least 6 oz.

Jugs: such as milk, detergent, fabric softener

Jars: such as peanut butter

Bottles: such as water, soda, shampoo

Tubs: such as yogurt, butter, cottage cheese

Clamshells: such as deli/fresh produce

Metals: Aluminum or tin cans.

Glass: Bottles & jars ONLY.

Paper: Newspaper, dry food boxes, magazines/catalogs, (including glossy ads), telephone books, junk mail, cardboard, paper bags/sacks, gift wrap. Place loose in container, remove liners and flatten all boxes.

NOT ACCEPTED IN RURAL BOXES:
 Pet food bags, plastic bags/wrap, plastic storage bins, planters/pots, plastic toys, aseptic (paper) cartons, foil or oil/hazardous waste containers.

Free Bulky Waste

This program allows **FREE** disposal of inert demolition waste (includes large yard waste, furniture, mattresses, carpeting, roofing, laminate flooring, drywall, bricks, hay, sawdust, sod, untreated wood, etc.)

Limit of 2 large appliances & 4 passenger tires without rims per Saturday. Sites **do not accept:** any plastic/rubber items, small appliances or household waste.

Rural Latah County addresses only, no residents within city limits of Moscow or any businesses.

Deary: 2nd & 4th Saturdays 8am - 4pm
 Line Street behind elevators

Genesee: 2nd & 4th Saturdays 8am - 4pm
 Morscheck Road

Juliaetta: 1st & 3rd Saturdays 8am - 4pm
 South on Hwy 3 past the ball park

Potlatch: 1st & 3rd Saturdays 8am - 4pm
 South on Pine Street ¼ mile to the old pit

Troy/Moscow: 2nd & 4th Saturdays 8am - 4pm
 3299 Highway 8 East, Transfer Station

Dumping at any other time is a prosecutable offense. Report abuse for proper clean-up.

Use weekly driveway service for household waste. E-waste must be recycled at Moscow Recycling Center.

April and October are clean up months with FREE disposal of all waste excluding electronic or hazardous waste, which must be taken to the proper facility for free disposal.
