MISSION

The Latah County Youth Advocacy Council (LCYAC) is youth, families and community organizations collaborating to reduce youth substance use in Latah County.

HISTORY

Since 2006, LCYAC has been funded by grants and donations through Latah County Youth Services. The program employs three staff and the operations and budget are managed by a diverse board of Latah County residents. LCYAC is a member of Community Anti-drug Coalitions of America (CADCA).

GOALS

- Address factors that contribute to high risk behaviors.
 - Help communities assess local needs, choose strategies and implement evidence based drug prevention programs.
 - Develop effective community coalitions.

YOUTH AMBASSADOR PROGRAM
