Filed the Final Environmental Evaluation for the Latah Trail, submitted by Bionomics, Inc.

Filed the Surface Transportation Board decision of the Palouse River & Coulee City Railroad, Inc. Abandonment Exemption, decided: May 7, 2002 for a 180 day extension.
