Week of August 18, 2003

Commissioners Tom S. Stroschein, and John A. Nelson met in regular session on Monday, August 18, 2003, on Thursday, August 21, 2003, and again on Friday, August 22, 2003; the following actions were taken:

Approved, signed and filed a request for a tax cancellation in behalf of Ron and Susan Mahoney, RP0176000005B.

Approved, signed and filed a request for a tax cancellation in behalf of Pat Garrett, RPM00000070521A.

Approved, signed and filed a request for a 7-year increment increase for Vicky MacArthur, Social Services Director, Department 01D, Line 02, effective August 1, 2003.

Approved, signed and filed a request for a 1-year increment increase for Deann Billing, Auditor Assistant, Department 01B, Line 03, effective August 1, 2003.

Filed the resignation of Jennifer Douglass, Law Clerk, Department 01AA, Line 01, effective August 22, 2003.

Filed the resignation of Larry Betts from the Zoning Commission.

Filed a notice of receipt of Appeal, No.03-A-2114, PPG Industries, Inc., Parcel No. PPP254, from the Board of Tax Appeals.

Filed the Public Defender Hours for the month of July, 2003, as submitted by Charles Kovis.

Approved, signed, and filed a request to issue a master key to Sandy Rollins, Disaster Services Coordinator.

By Motion and Order, approved the Access Idaho Premium Exempt Service Agreement between Latah County and the Idaho Department of Transportation to facilitate the process of identification from a first time mail-in registrant as required by HAVA (Help America Vote Act); effective August 18, 2003..

Approved, signed and filed a request for Tuition Aid to North Idaho College, by Shona Davenport.

Filed a copy of a letter from ICRMP denying claim for damages by Scott Szasz, Robinson Park.

Signed the NACo Early Childhood and School Readiness Grant Agreement as approved by Motion and Order on May 14, 2003.

Approved, signed and filed a request for a 2-year increment increase for Maurika

Brooks-Wittman, 4-H Program Assistant, Department 10, Line 05, effective July 1, 2003.

By Motion and Order, signed a Professional Services Agreement between Latah County and Rich Levensgood for the development of the Emergency Operations Plan project, not to exceed \$10,000.00; effective July 25th, 2003 through December 1, 2003.

By Motion and Order, pursuant to Idaho Code 67-2345, (1)(d), convened in executive session at 9:42 a.m. on August 18, 2003, to discuss records exempt from public inspection; Indigent. Adjourned at 10:07 a.m. Four cases approved, zero cases denied.

By Motion and Order, having held a public hearing as required by law, adjusted the 2002-2003 budget as follows:

1. Increased the Fair Operation Budget, Line 07-00-0724-0000, Entertainment, in the amount of \$10,444 from \$2,700 to \$13,144 – revenue Donations for Entertainment; and
2. Increased Justice – Prosecuting Attorney Budget, Line 08-07-0439-0000, Travel, in the amount of \$406 from \$14,000 to \$14,406 – revenue Idaho Juvenile Corrections; and
3. Increased the Historic Preservation Grant Budget, Line 60-00-0521-0000, Operating Expense in the amount of \$300 from \$1,000 to \$1,300 – revenue State of Idaho.

These funds are unscheduled revenue and the expenditure of these funds will be at no additional cost to the taxpayers of Latah County.

By Motion and Order, pursuant to Idaho Code 67-2345, (1)(f), convened in executive session at 9:04 a.m. on August 21, 2003, to discuss litigation. Adjourned at 10:10 a.m.

Having held a public hearing on August 15, 2003 in the matter of the Goesling Appeal #647, met for Deliberations and Decision on August 22, 2003 at 9:00 a.m. The Board, moved to overturn the determination of zoning violation of the Latah County Planning and Building Department finding the residential occupancy of William Gosling's accessory building at 1145 Paradise Ridge Road is in violation of the Latah County Zoning Ordinance and declare the use of said building as a residence for persons engaged for farm or forestry labor as a designed use protected by Idaho Code Section 67-6538. The site is currently referenced as assessor's parcel number RP39N05W298115A; directed Planning Department to prepare Findings of Fact and Order. Motion passed unanimously.
