A fire protection district is proposed for an area located in Latah County and in Nez Perce County, State of Idaho, "Juliaetta, and Kendrick and the surrounding area" as shown on the map filed with the Clerk of the Latah County Board of Commissioners and the Clerk of the Nez Perce County Board of Commissioners. The name of the district will be "J-K Unified Volunteer Fire District."

The purpose of formation of a fire protection district is the protection of property against fire and the preservation of life and is declared by the State of Idaho to be a public benefit, use and purpose.

Upon formation of a district all taxable property within the boundaries of said district shall be assessed equally in proportion to its assessed valuation to defray the cost of equipping and maintaining the district. The maximum tax rate that would be imposed upon taxable property is .0008.
