Now is the time to start updating your voter registrations and requesting an absentee ballot for the upcoming 2016 Elections. This will include school district levy, Presidential Primary, Primary, General, any financial taxing district elections, and Soil and Conservation District Election.

If your address has changed we will need an updated Federal Post Card Applications (FPCA) with the correct mailing addresses no later than January 22, 2015 for the levy elections and Presidential Primary on March 8, 2016; April 1, 2016 for Primary, levy and taxing district financial elections on May 17, 2015; July 29, 2015 for the *possible* August 30, 2016 Election or September 23, 2016 for the General, Soil and Conservation and any taxing district financial elections on November 8, 2016. Our goal is to get absentee ballots mailed to you as soon as possible so that they can be returned in time to be counted.

Please be sure to complete the FPCA including all the necessary information and identification required by the State of Idaho, Email addresses and complete telephone numbers are very helpful in the absentee voting process.

REMEMBER: Voter registration closes 25 days before every election date.
