

Latah County Planning Commission
Minutes 16 December 2003

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Latah County Planning Commission held on the 16th day of December, 2003, at the Latah County Courthouse Room 2B was called to order at 5:30 PM. The meeting minutes from December 2, 2003 were accepted. The Public Hearing on the Moscow Area of City Impact Agreement began at 5:35 PM, nine members of the public attended. All members of the public left after the hearing had concluded.

The remainder of the meeting was spent discussing recommendations to make to the Latah Board of County Commissioners regarding the Moscow Area of City Impact. Six motions were made and seconded by Suvia Judd and Kathleen Warnick respectively. Each motion was in turn adopted by the Planning Commission.

1. Motion: That the Planning Commission recommends the Latah Board of County Commissioners adopt the draft Moscow Area of City Impact Agreement.
2. Motion: That the Planning Commission recommends the Latah Board of County Commissioners adopt the draft Latah County, Idaho Ordinance No. 247 Moscow Area of City Impact Ordinance which contains the details of the Moscow Area of City Impact Agreement.
3. Motion: That the Planning Commission recommends the Latah Board of County Commissioners adopt the draft Latah County, Idaho Ordinance No. 246 Moscow Area of City Impact Map Ordinance.
4. Motion: That the Planning Commission recommends the Latah Board of County Commissioners adopt the proposed changes to the Latah County Comprehensive Plan Map to reflect the new Moscow Area of City Impact, the potential "beltway road", and changes to comprehensive plan designations for areas no longer within the Moscow Area of City Impact.
5. Motion: That the Planning Commission finds the proposed amendment to the Latah County Zoning Ordinance and the Official Zoning Map of Latah County in accordance with the Latah County Comprehensive Plan and recommends the amendment be adopted by the Latah Board of County Commissioners.
6. Motion: That the Planning Commission recommends the Latah Board of County Commissioners move ahead in a leadership role to form a county transportation planning "task force" with representatives from all relevant public entities, drawing on latest in transportation science and inviting the public to participate early in the process.
