### Adoption of Minutes:

PC began with discussion regarding minutes from last meeting. Minutes approved as read.

### Discussion re: CP Workshops:

JH reported she is contacting the Cattlemen's Association and that she contacted the Grain Growers, but they are busy right now and will possibly be interested in a workshop in the fall.

Murray reported he is communicating with the Hatley Horse Council.

BH suggested that the PC should consider sending questions out for people to review prior to conducting workshops. He and Murray will try this strategy at their next meeting. MF suggested asking people if they would like to commit to two workshops, one to learn about the comprehensive plan and another to complete the workshop.

The PC heard comments on the Latah County Democrats workshop; workshop too late at night, too many paired couples. The PC heard comments on the 4-H leaders workshop; comments included appreciation for agriculture vibrancy, small scale ag, and transportation. PC heard comments on the workshop conducted in the Federal building; comments included interest in maintaining ag/forest not just for ag/forest but also for the views of ag/forest.

BH reported that he discussed workshop with Deary High School principal, and idea of doing workshop with the government class and possibility of reaching out to entire families.
