Meeting was called to order at 5:30pm by Janet H., Chair. Those present were Cindy A, Bob H, Sid E, Steve H, Suvia J, and Janet H.

Sid made a motion to allow Bob to add a new agenda item to the LCPC planned agenda and Steve seconded it and unanimously passed. The agenda item is titled "Bob reads an article titled "Widespread Food Contamination"". Bob read an article on food contamination.

Suvia made a motion to add another agenda item, it was seconded by Bob and unanimously passed. The agenda item is titled "Suvia hands out a pamphlet on "N.W. Permaculture Conference"". Suvia presented leaflets for all regarding the Inland Northwest Permaculture Conference that will held in Spokane on Nov.4 -6.

Janet began our discussion on Section 8.01, ask if there were anymore ideas regarding land division. Suvia said she felt that we may add something that would direct growth towards cities and towns, maybe possibly by adding zones along the highways or by parameters, i.e. areas not further than a mile off the highway, or on a bus route. Also she had concerns to allow easier splits into clustered areas. Discussion ensued.

Janet handed out some examples other counties had with addressing splits and clustered housing and encouraged us to look at this and other counties and see what they do for our next meeting.
